Over the next decade, 4.6 million manufacturing jobs will likely be needed.

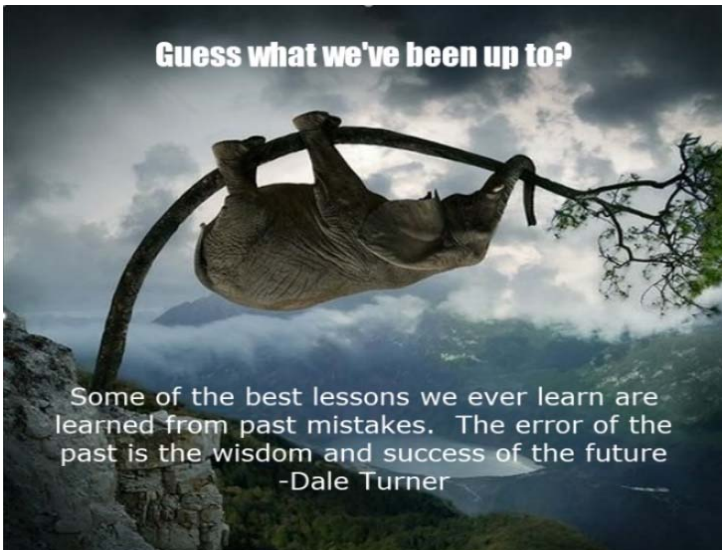
