



COVID CORNER - UPDATE 10/20/2020

The Oregon Health Authority has expanded the Mask requirements.

All business including manufacturing must provide and require employees to wear a face mask.

This includes:

- Offices-unless it's an individual workspace not shared with other people. Single occupancy offices and cubicles are exempt.
- Workstations
- Hallways
- Restrooms
- Break Rooms
- Meeting rooms and other common and shared spaces.

Basically, whenever you leave your workstation you must wear a mask.

OHA is also stating that face shields are not recommended without added protection of a face mask.

Accommodations will be made to those that have a medical condition that makes it hard to breathe or a disability that prevents the individual from wearing a mask, face covering or face shield. You can request an accommodation from the business or indoor/outdoor space operator to enable full and equal access to services, transportation and facilities open to the public.

WPI – Meetings are now limited to no more than 4 in a room at a time. If your meeting is scheduled to include 4+ attendees, it must be done via zoom, conference call etc.

We must continue to be very careful to avoid exposure and suffer illness. Continue social distancing, sanitizing and PPE when in public.

Visitors allowed by invitation only. No impromptu visits, this includes customers, vendors, etc.
