



COVID CORNER - UPDATE 11/01/2020

EXPOSURE POTENTIAL IS INCREASING

It is time for everyone to review the FLOWCHART in the event you have had exposure to someone that has COVID-19. The Flowchart for Exposure has been revised to reflect testing requirements and mandatory quarantine times.

First and foremost, write down who you have been close to in the last few days. Everyone that you have had less than 6' distance for 15 minutes or more. In the event you test positive you will need to provide this information to your care provider, possibly the CDC or local health authorities, and Human Resources.

Once you begin the quarantine period, wait for at least 4 days to get tested for the Coronavirus. Medical providers are stating that it is advisable to wait to get tested for 4-7 days after your exposure unless you are ill, fever, cough, loss of smell and/or taste.

Everyone has been doing an excellent job wearing masks, face coverings as required. Regardless of our personal beliefs or opinions, this is a regulation that we must adhere to. It is our intent to keep our doors open, keep us working, keep us all healthy and safe.

WPI – Meetings are now limited to no more than 5 in a room at a time, maintain a 6' social distance and wearing masks at all times during the meeting. If your meeting is scheduled to include 5+ attendees, it must be done via zoom, conference call etc.

We must continue to be very careful to avoid exposure and suffer illness. Continue social distancing, sanitizing and PPE when in public.

Visitors allowed by invitation only. No impromptu visits, this includes customers, vendors, etc.
