COUNTY RE-OPENING PHASE ONE

With the current ordinance in place as of May 15, 2020 to begin opening our counties, WPI will continue to adhere to the guidelines that have been in place: This notice is just a reminder that we still need to adhere to our practices and take precaution as we have been.

Meetings are allowed up to 4 people, social distancing must be maintained. It is strongly suggested to continue with holding meetings via Zoom whenever possible. Maintain records of all meetings; Meeting Title, Date and Everyone who attends a meeting must sign in as record and documentation of the meeting. Below is the actual verbiage under the May 15th re-open guidelines.

- Local cultural, civic and faith gatherings are allowed for up to 25 people provided physical distancing can be in place.
- Local social gatherings over 10 people are prohibited and those under 10 people must use physical distancing.

Maintaining Social Distancing – WPI will continue to maintain social distancing as we have been doing.

WPI will continue with cleaning and sanitizing as we have been doing for the past couple of months. We will continue checking in customers, vendors and visitors as we have been. Scheduling appointments is still necessary to prevent unnecessary visitors.

If you are sick stay at home; we do not want to risk exposure of any illness.

Please take caution and don't let your guard down in regard to exposure to this or any other virus. The potential for illness is still very relevant – Be Safe, Be Well.
